








Curiouser QAL Block 9 - Bouquet


All seam allowances are scant 0.25", and the finished square will measure 12.5"


Materials


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 3 squares (4.5" x 4.5") print (way bigger than necessary, 4" x 4" should be enough)
 
 2 x border rectangles (2.5" x 10" deliberately longer than needed)
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 3 squares (4.5" x 4.5") plain (way bigger than necessary, 4" x 4" should be enough)
 
 2 x border rectangles (2.5" x 13" deliberately longer than needed)
- 
 3 squares (3.5" x 3.5") plain


 Pair each 4.5" print squares with a 4.5" plain squares. With your fabric marker, trace a line on the diagonal of the back of the plain squares.


 Add borders as for previous weeks, then trim to size (12.5").


 Sew 1/4" on each side of the line. Cut and press open. You now have 6 HSTs.


 Trim each blocks to 3.5", preserving the diagonal, by lining up the 45 degrees line of your ruler with the diagonal.


 Arrange your blocks and sew them line by line. Then sew each lines together. The block should measure 9.5".
